Presbyterian Disaster Assistance - Hurricane Relief

The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), through the work of Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, is on the ground responding to the many urgent needs following the destruction Hurricanes Helene and Milton left in their paths.

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA), has been in constant communication with leadership in the impacted areas. Emergency grants have been distributed to address the most urgent needs, and National Response Teams have been deployed to provide assistance to churches and to help coordinate the Church's response.

It will take years to recover. After initial needs are addressed, PDA will remain - providing emotional and spiritual care and long-term recovery to address unmet and ongoing needs.

The needs for the response will be great. God's people are called on to stand in the "GAP" - Give. Act. Pray.
